ACC members have drawn from our combined experience and conducted research into internationally recognized safe cycling practices. This research led to a report identifying 3 key recommendations to modify the Alberta Traffic Safety Act:

Our key recommendations are:

1. Require safe passing distance of one metre, and 1.5m at speeds greater than 60km/h
2. Allow two abreast riding, when not impeding reasonable flow of traffic
3. Cyclists to ride as far to the right as is safe, versus as is practicable
